Laboratory Manager

The laboratory manager will receive conceptual and hands-on training in longitudinal biobehavioral research with pregnant individuals and infants. The laboratory manager will work closely with Dr. Shuffrey to oversee lab administration for all projects within the lab. Duties will include building and maintaining laboratory infrastructure, serving as a liaison to collaborators, spearheading IRB approvals for ongoing studies, and assisting in data collection.

Required education and expertise: Bachelor's degree in Psychology, Neuroscience, Cognitive Science, or Human Development, or a related field. The position requires excellent organizational skills, attention to detail, and strong interpersonal skills. Prior experience working with pregnant individuals, infants, and/or with clinical research coordination is preferred. The position is available beginning July 2023 and requires a two-year commitment. Individuals with diverse perspectives are especially encouraged to apply.
