Job Description: This is a volunteer research position that gives undergraduates the opportunity to conduct clinical research in psychiatry at Massachusetts General Hospital during the 2014-2015 academic year. Volunteers will assist on a study (PI: Luana Marques, PhD) of implementation and dissemination of evidence-based treatments for mental health in community-based health centers. Specifically, Dr. Marques' study examines the implementation of Cognitive Processing Therapy for PTSD at MGH Chelsea HealthCare Center in Chelsea, MA. Volunteers will be responsible for data entry (both quantitative and qualitative) and analysis, writing IRB proposals, performing literature searches, assisting on grant proposal preparations, and assisting with other study-related tasks.

Applicants should have an interest in pursuing a graduate degree in clinical psychology, psychiatry, or public health. **Spanish-speaking applicants preferred**, although all are encouraged to apply.
