

## APA Summer Science Fellowships for undergraduates

The Science Directorate of the American Psychological Association (APA) will sponsor its [Summer Science Fellowship](#) program, hosted by the Psychology Department at George Mason University, June 21-Aug. 2, 2014. Up to 12 students who are current juniors will be selected for this six-week, paid summer research internship. Students will be selected for experiences in one of several areas of psychology, including biological, applied developmental, applied cognitive, neuroscience, clinical, school and industrial/organizational.

Students currently enrolled in U.S. or Canadian colleges are eligible. International students at U.S. or Canadian institutions may apply; U.S. citizenship is not required. Students from underrepresented groups are especially encouraged to apply.

The application deadline is **Feb. 10, 2014**. Please encourage your best students to apply for this outstanding program.
