

FULL-TIME CLINICAL RESEARCH OPPORTUNITY FOR POST-GRADUATES

Research Description: Our research is interested in understanding the relationship between the brain and diseases including cognitive dysfunction, diabetes and obesity.

Position Description: This position for a full-time research associate is jointly sponsored by investigators in the Departments of Endocrinology and Neurology at the Yale School of Medicine. The position is ideal for an individual interested in pursuing a career in medicine and would like to gain experience working in clinical research. The position will require excellent people skills as applicant will be working directly with research participants in clinical settings including clinics, MRI, neuro-critical care intensive care unit, and operating rooms. Activities would include coordinating research subject visits, subject recruitment, research sample collection, data entry, data analysis, and questionnaire administration. The research associate would gain valuable experience in a clinical setting and will be listed as a co-author on any publications.

Requirements: Applicants should have a Bachelors degree and have graduated in good academic standing. An interest in medicine, biology, neuroscience, neurology or endocrinology is preferred but not necessary. Ideal start date would be Sept/Oct 2015 but we could be flexible.
