

## **Full-time Research Specialist Position: The Princeton Social Neuroscience Lab**

The Princeton Social Neuroscience Lab, directed by Diana Tamir, is seeking a full-time research specialist (i.e., lab manager/research assistant) to begin in August 2015. The lab uses functional neuroimaging, behavioral techniques, and machine learning to study the cognitive and neural basis of self-referential thought and social behaviors. This position would be ideal for those interested in pursuing graduate school in psychology or neuroscience, as the research specialist will gain experience with all aspects of the research process. Primary responsibilities will include: (1) recruiting and testing human subjects, (2) assisting with the design and implementation of behavioral and fMRI experiments, (3) managing and analyzing behavioral and fMRI data, and (4) setting up and maintaining operations of the new lab through general administrative duties.

This position is designed for an individual with a BS or BA in psychology, cognitive science, neuroscience, computer science, or related fields. Previous independent research experience in social psychology or cognitive neuroscience, strong statistical background, programming skills, and experience managing teams of people would be highly desired, but not required.
