

The Harvard Laboratory for Youth Mental Health (sites.harvard.edu/jweisz) is currently seeking volunteer research assistants to work on two projects: (1) child emotion regulation strategies associated with developmental psychopathology and (2) a study of exposure therapy for anxious youths and parent-child relationships. Data collection for Study 1 will be ongoing in the Summer and Fall of 2015. Data collection for Study 2 has been completed. The position will be based at William James Hall under the direction of Dr. John Weisz, Professor of Psychology, and graduate student, Nancy Lau.

Responsibilities may include: participant recruitment, running study participants, literature searches and summaries, data entry and data analysis, videocoding of parent-child behavioral interactions, attending research meetings, and other supporting activities.

Job Requirements: A two semester commitment is required. Students must be available to volunteer for 12-15 hours a week. Weekend availability on Saturdays and/or Sundays for running parent and child participants is required.
