

The Division of Digital Psychiatry at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center is currently recruiting students to apply to our research academy for the Fall 2026 Cohort. The program cycles students through data-driven research and clinical experiences over 1-2 years. The time commitment is a minimum of 5 hours a week for 1-2 years. Must be Boston-based.

- **First semester (September - January):** MindBench, MindApps research contribution. Weekly readings, presentations from lab researchers and discussions spanning AI ethics to Digital Phenotyping. (5 hours per week and biweekly virtual meetings)
- **Second semester (January - June):** DOORS, co-leading digital literacy programming across Boston. (5 hours per week, 2-3 hours per week of in-person programming)
- **Year 2 (September - June):** Students can apply to be Digital Navigators in our Digital Clinic, where they provide 1-on-1 support directly to our patients, helping them navigate their behavioral data. (8-10 hours per week)

We are currently interviewing and accepting students on a rolling basis; the first cohort begins 9/10/26. If possible, could you please share the following [application form](#) with your students?
