

**Full-Time Research Assistant Position at the University of Chicago –  
Clinical Addictions Research Laboratory**

The Clinical Addictions Research Laboratory (CARL) directed by Dr. Andrea King at the University of Chicago is seeking a full-time research assistant to provide ongoing clinical research support.

Current projects include human laboratory studies of responses to alcohol in people with alcohol use disorder, smartphone-based studies of alcohol use in risky drinkers in the natural environment, and virtual vaping and smoking cue studies. Other opportunities are available to assist with text messaging interventions for young adults who vape and in clinical programs in underserved and medically-compromised people who smoke. The research assistant will provide support in all areas of clinical investigation, including but not limited to: participant recruitment, interviewing and screening; conducting experimental sessions, database management, and follow-up assessments; providing administrative and infrastructure support in literature reviews, equipment calibration and maintenance, and organizing and filing records and study materials.
