

Clinical Research Position with the Harvard Ophthalmology Metabolomics in Retina (HOMeR) Program at Mass Eye and Ear

**POSITION SUMMARY:**

Under the direction of the Principal Investigator, the Research Technician (RT) will provide laboratory preclinical and clinical research assistance for projects related to Age-related Macular Degeneration (AMD) in the Harvard Ophthalmology Metabolomics in Retina (HOMeR) Program.

The RT will work independently under the general direction of the PI to coordinate human research studies and assist in data analysis and research reporting. On the clinical research side, the RT will be responsible for research subject pre-screening, scheduling, enrollment, and sample collection, and some imaging. Further, the RT will help prepare and maintain human subject research (IRB) protocols and associated documentation. The RT will also have an opportunity to help the PI and other members of the team with developing data processing and analysis methods.
