



Full-Time Clinical Research Coordinator Position

The Cincinnati Infant Neurodevelopment Early Prediction Study (CINEPS) study at Cincinnati Children's Hospital anticipates hiring a full-time clinical research position to start as soon as possible. Individuals in this position will work on a federally funded research project under the supervision of neonatologist Nehal Parikh, D.O., and clinical psychologist, Leanne Tamm, Ph.D.

The CINEPS study is following a group of children born very preterm to see if neuroimaging data collected at birth can predict who is at risk of neurodevelopmental challenges (e.g., poor cognition, risk of an ADHD or autism diagnosis, behavioral or learning difficulties, and others). The children are currently being assessed at age 5 years and 7 years. We are also recruiting a group of full-term born children to serve as comparison children.

We are looking for a full-time bachelor's level clinical research coordinator. The coordinator will work with the investigators and other coordinators on day-to-day study activities, including recruitment and scheduling, conducting study visits (cognitive and academic assessments, magnetic resonance imaging scanning visits), gathering teacher rating scales, scoring, reports, data management, and data entry.

This position requires in-person work in Cincinnati conducting study visits. Applicants of diverse and underrepresented backgrounds are especially encouraged to apply.

Other research and clinical opportunities:

- Monthly didactics focused on and clinical issues
- Lead the preparation of a conference presentation

To be eligible:

- Must have completed a bachelor's degree in psychology or related field
- Have some research experience
