The Food and Addiction Science and Treatment (FAST) Lab at the University of Michigan (PI: Ashley Gearhardt; <https://sites.lsa.umich.edu/fastlab/>) is hiring for a full-time Research Technician (Data Manager). The lab studies how ultra-processed foods influence reward functioning, mood, and well-being using methods including neuroimaging, continuous blood glucose monitoring, ecological momentary assessment, and experimental and survey designs with human participants. The successful candidate will contribute to multiple stages of research, including recruitment and collection of human subjects data; management, cleaning, and analysis of lab datasets; supporting literature reviews and manuscripts; and supporting ongoing lab needs including supervising and training lab personnel (i.e. undergraduate research assistants). Strong skills in R are particularly encouraged, and SPSS experience is beneficial.

This position provides opportunities to gain experience in advanced research methods, and is ideal for individuals interested in pursuing graduate studies in psychology (i.e. clinical).

The position is full-time for one year, with the possibility of renewal, with an anticipated start date of Spring or early Summer 2026.
