We have an exciting opportunity to join our team as a lab manager in the Stress and Resilience Research program at the San Francisco VA Medical Center and UCSF. Research projects investigate pharmaceutical and behavioral treatments for Posttraumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) and insomnia; fear conditioning; psychophysiological, endocrine, immune and -omic studies; remote experiments, and the effect of stress on women's cardiovascular and reproductive health. Studies are also being conducted in coordination with other sites in the US.

The lab manager will be responsible for grant submissions, budget planning and management, regulatory paperwork, manuscript preparation, and day-to-day management of study activities, including trial conduct and coordination with other study sites.

In addition to the primary responsibilities, there may be opportunity for a motivated individual to be involved in aspects of study design, development of new grants and/or independent scientific publications.

Research is conducted at the San Francisco VA Medical Center and at the University of California, San Francisco. We are seeking candidates who would be able to commit for 2 years, with possibility for renewal. US citizenship is required.
