

## Lab Manager in the Ellman Lab at Temple University

The Ellman lab in the Psychology and Neuroscience Department at Temple University is seeking a full-time lab manager to take a leadership role in the lab assisting with grants management, budgets (including NIH budgets), other lab administrative duties, and supervision of other lab staff.
