We are seeking 2 post-baccalaureate researchers in the Department of Psychology and Neuroscience at UNC Chapel Hill to work on joint projects with Drs. Eva Telzer and Mitch Prinstein. The researchers would work on unique datasets that combines theories and methods in developmental neuroscience (longitudinal fMRI data), social affective neuroscience (emotional processing, social interactions), health behaviors (health risk behaviors, internalizing and externalizing disorders), developmental psychopathology, and social media and technology use. We are especially looking for researchers to assist with recruitment, screening, and data collection with adolescent participants and their families. The position is a great fit for those who wish to gain more research experience before applying to graduate school. The applicant must have a BA in Psychology, Neuroscience, or related field by the time the position begins. The position also includes opportunities for professional development and unique interdisciplinary training that will be useful for a variety of academic career paths. Positions begin summer 2026 (specific start date flexible). Applicants should submit a CV, cover letter, and list of 2-3 references for initial review.
