Location: The Ohio State University, in-person (fully remote candidates will not be considered)

Duties:

- o Screening and enrolling participants
- o Conducting baseline and lab sessions
- o Managing participant data/results
- o Writing and preparing manuscripts for publication
- o Collaborating with The Columbus Foundation on outreach and philanthropy related tasks (up to 10 hours per week of outreach)

Commitment: One-year commitment required; two years preferred
