The Women's Mood Clinic at the UC San Diego Department of Psychiatry will soon be hiring a full-time research associate. This position would be an excellent fit for those interested in women's mental health, particularly those considering future graduate training. The position is in-person at the Child & Adolescent Services Research Center in San Diego, so applicants must be willing to relocate to beautiful Southern California! 😊

Investigators are researching the biological mechanisms involved in the Sleep & Light Intervention (SALI), a non-pharmacological, at-home intervention for depression. The current study is focused on women in the menopausal transition. The research associate will gain extensive hands-on experience with clinical research procedures, participant interaction, REDCap data systems, the Sleep & Light Intervention (SALI), and community outreach while working closely with our multidisciplinary research team. The position includes participant-facing responsibilities such as Zoom screening visits and informed consent procedures, as well as home visits for study equipment support and instruction on study procedures. Excellent interpersonal and organizational skills, as well as reliable transportation, are essential.
