

The Georgetown Univ. Medical Center's Anxiety Disorders Research Program is accepting applications for a Research Assistant (RA) position to start June 2025. The RA will be responsible for managing the operations of clinical trials and research projects with anxiety and mood disorders and treatments including pharmacotherapy and mindfulness meditation, under the direct supervision of Dr. Elizabeth Hoge.

Responsibilities include: participant recruitment (e.g. strategizing to find participants, managing online ads, conducting phone interviews to assess fit with study inclusion/exclusion criteria and match participants to studies for initial screening visit), data entry and cleaning, preparation and modification of IRB documents, volunteer training, data analysis and interpretation, manuscript development (literature reviews, reference management, report preparation), and grant writing.

Qualified applicants must have achieved a B.A. or B.S. in Psychology or a related field and should have prior research experience. REDCap and STATA experience is a plus but not required. Applicant must be comfortable with independent work. The position is for one year (with a possibility for 2) and offers valuable clinical research experience in preparation for applying to graduate school in clinical psychology or medical school.
