

Research Coordinator in the NEAR Lab at Northwestern University

Dr. Brent Rappaport is seeking a full-time research coordinator to assist with an ongoing K23 project at Northwestern University in downtown Chicago, IL. Broadly, research examines (a) basic mechanisms and risk factors underlying mood and anxiety disorders in adolescents and adulthood, and (b) novel treatments for these conditions. Our lab utilizes multiple methods in this work, including behavioral, physiological, neural, and digital tools. You will be joining other RAs, postdocs, and faculty in the NEAR Lab led by Dr. Stewart Shankman, and will have the opportunity to gain experience in experimental design, recruitment, data collection and analysis. Abundant opportunities for co-authoring manuscripts and conference presentations will also be available. The position will also provide the opportunity to learn about brain-based and psychopathological theory and research more broadly, as well as learn and develop clinical interviewing skills. Successful applicants will have experience in psychological, neuroscience (or related area) research, quantitative data analysis, and coding skills, and have strong organizational and writing skills.
