We are looking for a highly motivated individual to join our team starting July 1st (start date is negotiable). This coordinator will work on research projects centered on reducing mental health disparities in Latino/a/x youth and families.

Responsibilities include:

- Recruiting and running participants through study protocols
- Monitoring and managing collected data
- Assisting with IRB submissions and maintenance
- Coordinating participant compensation
- Assist in establishing and maintaining relationships with community partners
- Support study community outreach efforts
- Oversee and support undergraduate research assistants

Preferred qualifications:

- Bilingual in English and Spanish (fluent verbal and written communication)
- At least one year of research experience with human subjects
- Experience with community-engaged research
- Strong interpersonal and communication (verbal and written) preferred

Because this position will be working with youth and families, some evening and weekend work may be required.

This is an excellent position for those planning to apply to doctoral programs in psychology, particularly those interested in culturally responsive and/or community-engaged mental health research. Opportunities to present posters at conferences and to submit manuscripts will be available depending on the candidate's interest.
