

## SEEKING A RESEARCH COORDINATOR

The Child Cognitive Behavioral Program at MGH is seeking a research coordinator to work on a pilot project testing whether we can feasibly and effectively screen and intervene with 2-year-olds at risk for anxiety disorders. This position will start in June, 2023.

Tasks include recruiting subjects, screening participants by telephone, coordinating patient appointments, assisting with assessments, and collecting, scoring, entering and managing questionnaire data.

Requirements include a bachelor's degree in psychology or a related field (by June, 2023), undergraduate research experience, good attention to detail, strong interpersonal skills, and ability to work well with a team. Experience with young children is preferred.
