Brown Medical School researchers working within the Behavioral Medicine and Addictions Research Group at Butler Hospital are seeking a Research Assistant for NIH-funded studies on behavioral and mind-body interventions for alcohol and opioid use disorders, chronic pain, and trauma. Interventions studied include physical activity interventions, yoga-based interventions, mindful self-compassions, and mHealth approaches.

Responsibilities: Position includes screening, recruiting and interviewing study participants, managing research data and collaborating with other study staff in related duties.

Knowledge of clinical research procedures, experience conducting diagnostic interviews, and fluency in Spanish is a plus.

A successful applicant will be motivated and detail-oriented, able to work independently, and have strong organizational and communication skills.

Position is full time with benefits and involves opportunities for developing clinical and research skills in collaborative, supportive environment.

Requirements: BA in psychology or related experience required. Flexibility to work occasional evenings and weekend hours is required. As some data collection may be off-site, applicants need to provide their own transportation.
