

Research Assistant at UCLA and VA Greater Los Angeles Healthcare System

We are currently looking to hire **2-3 full-time research assistants** to join our clinical research team based in the UCLA Department of Psychiatry and the VA Greater Los Angeles. We are looking for people who have completed either a BA or MS, with the specific research duties depending on the level of training. Most of the research activities require the recruiting, interviewing, and testing (cognitive, EEG, and fMRI) of individuals with schizophrenia and comparison groups. We have a separate line of research on community integration for homeless individuals.

Work will be done under the immediate supervision of a senior project coordinator and the work will occur at either the clinical research labs at the VA Greater Los Angeles or on the UCLA campus (which are close to each other). Applicants will need to work effectively as a contributing member of a relatively large clinical research team. In addition, applicants should have strong interpersonal skills for working with people with severe mental illness and / or a history of homelessness. Additional duties will include test scheduling, data management, and file maintenance. This position is well suited for individuals who wish to gain research and clinical experience prior to graduate or medical school.

The individuals hired for these positions will work closely with a team of SRP-affiliated investigators, including Drs. Michael Green, Jonathan Wynn, Amy Jimenez, Eric Reavis, Lauren Catalano, and Derek Novacek, as well as postdoctoral fellows.
