**Job Description**

The Gratton laboratory in the Psychology Department at Florida State University in Tallahassee, FL (<https://psy.fsu.edu/>) is looking for a full-time research tech to join in on exciting functional neuroimaging research on personalized brain networks. The Gratton Lab studies human brain networks and how they contribute to goal-directed behaviors. Our lab asks: how do we coordinate activity across brain regions and what happens when these functions break down? We pursue these questions using rest and task fMRI, through data-driven and model-based analyses, in combination with other methods (behavioral, TMS, and lifespan datasets).

The research tech will focus on data analysis tasks for the laboratory. Specific duties associated with this position include the preprocessing and analysis of behavioral and fMRI data for research studies, management of the lab analysis pipeline, and training of other lab members in technical skills. This position will offer opportunities for authorship-level contributions on a variety of lab projects.

This position can begin as early as June 1, 2024 through Fall 2024 (start date flexible). The best match for this position will come with a commitment of working for at least two years in the lab to gain relevant skills; the position may also be extended for additional time.

**Minimum qualifications:**

- An undergraduate degree in computer science, psychology, neuroscience, or a related biology, health, or engineering field
- Strong attention to detail and organization
- Strong computational background

**Preferred qualifications:**

- Experience with MRI and/or other forms of neuroimaging data analysis
- Computational experience in UNIX and MATLAB
