  - **Today**, Jan. 29 is the deadline to [apply for admission](#) to the programs themselves and to [apply for funding](#).
  - Trento, Italy courses are preapproved to count as psych departmental advanced courses.

- [Non-Harvard Summer Abroad Programs](#) – **Due February 11, 2015 for students needing funding, April 1, 2015 if not applying for funding:** These programs are preapproved by Harvard and are posted through the Office of International Education. You will need to apply to the program itself by their application deadline, as well as apply to Harvard for credit. For coursework related to psychology, we recommend the **Sussex University program in the UK** and the **Danish Institute for Study** (coursework is conducted in English). For concentration credit you'll need [Laura Chivers](#) to sign off as the adviser on part IV of your [Harvard credit application](#) – email her to set up a meeting on a Monday or Thursday by **February 9** if you need to apply for funding.
