- 1. **The globalization project:** We investigate cultural variations "beyond East and West. This project involves extensive data collection in multiple global locations, including North America, East Asia, Latin America, South Asia, and Africa.
- 2. **Cultural neuroscience:** Currently, we seek to implement an EEG methodology for cross-cultural use.
- 3. **Culture and health** : As part of a large-scale project to simulate the disease process during the COVID-19 pandemic, we collect socio-cultural population-level variables likely to inform the disease process.
