Drs. Becca Brock and David DiLillo are seeking to hire a full-time Project Coordinator in support of a recently funded R01 from NIAAA that will examine the role of daily discrimination and alcohol use in the relationship functioning of rural sexual and gender minority couples. The Project Coordinator will manage participant recruitment and tracking, conduct interviews with potential participants, develop online surveys, assist with data management and analysis, help maintain IRB compliance, and supervise other research personnel. This position is ideal for someone planning to apply to graduate school who has interests in interpersonal trauma, couple relationships, and/or issues faced by rural LGBTQ+ individuals. In addition to the extensive experience running a large NIH project, there will be opportunities for involvement in publications and presentations and to receive mentorship for graduate school applications and career planning. Candidates must have behavioral/social science research experience, a commitment to working with underrepresented and marginalized populations, strong organizational skills and attention to detail, and good interpersonal skills. Experience coordinating or managing a research project or team is preferred.
