

Research Assistant in the Shankman Lab at Northwestern University

Dr. Stewart Shankman is seeking a full-time research study assistant for his lab at Northwestern University to assist on NIH and/or industry-funded projects. Broadly, research in the lab examines (a) basic mechanisms and risk factors underlying mood and anxiety disorders in adolescents and adulthood, and (b) novel treatments for these conditions. Our lab utilizes multiple methods in this work, including behavioral, physiological, neural, and digital tools. The Research Assistants will have the opportunity to gain experience in experimental design, recruitment, data collection and analysis. Abundant opportunities for co-authoring manuscripts and conference presentations will also be available. The position will also provide the opportunity to learn about brain-based and psychopathological theory and research more broadly, as well as clinical interviewing skills. Successful applicants will have experience in psychological, neuroscience (or related area) research, quantitative data analysis, and coding skills and have strong organizational and writing skills.
